April 8th Make Your Own Ice Cream Sundaes for \$2 (2:15 pm)

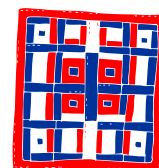
April 15th Carnival Food Court. Come and enjoy fried dough, snow cones, and cotton candy for \$1.00 (2:15 pm).

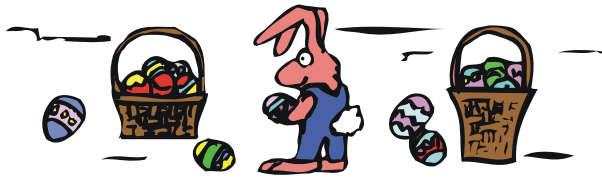
